Let's have a little fun on this Mathematical day and treat the DOES teachers and staff with: **some pie of course**!





Howard County School Budget Cuts

There are many reductions to the School Budget which impact our elementary students.

While we've heard about the music program being cut for 3rd graders, some other areas targeted are:

- \$4M cut to special education
- 20 positions cut from the Elementary School Gifted & Talented programs

And more reductions summarized on page 21 in the budget here.

We encourage you to email Calvin Ball, the Superintendent and the BOE asking them NOT to cut the budgets for those items. We recommend separate emails for each issue/proposed cut.
